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## **Practice**

Both Chas Reynolds and Richard Robarts were unhappy with their front brakes. Conversely, Stuart Barnes was pleased with the BSA gearbox now fitted in his lota as a replacement for the Burman.

The drive shaft repair to Ollie's Cooper again dropped him back to single wheel drive part way up, and the magneto repair to Mark's car let him down a second time. At this point Fin was clearly fastest and Alistair was the only other driver to dip below 60 seconds. John Chisholm was still having clutch problems and Stuart Wright was beginning to experience the same.

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## Timed runs

After lunch the weather had still not improved but times fell again for virtually all. Alistair had an uncharacteristic spin at Wis and the diminutive Monaco was experiencing gear selection issues. Ollie Dent was now sharing the Hornet with father Alistair. John Chisholm had been forced to pull out with more clutch issues and Mark's magneto problems also proved terminal, so neither recorded a time.



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Mid afternoon saw no change to conditions but familiarity and confidence saw times reduce again for nearly the whole field but especially for Simon Dedman, Richard Robarts and Stuart Barnes. Simon managed the fastest to 64ft of everyone all day. JB narrowly missed dipping under 60 seconds and was comfortably the quickest racer. Stuart W's chain tension was giving problems so he withdrew but an adjustment allowed Ed to complete a full set of runs on what had been a challenging day for a first 500 experience. Alistair had yet another uncharacteristic spin.

Once all the times had been checked, John 'Rain Master' Dent had been quickest of all, marginally ahead of the ever-consistent Fin, who together with Max won the Forsyth Cup for best family performance.

Although there were only three drivers in the larger capacity class after Charles Reynolds had been forced to withdraw his Cooper twin (he did however bring a very pretty Renault Alpine), it was very close between another father and son pairing, Mark and Russell Haynes. On the last run of the day, Russell just managed to find that little bit extra to take the win.
